Brief description

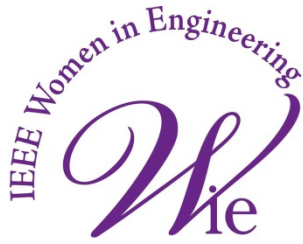
The *panel* "The Commitment Chart: The Youth Perspective" will be aimed at completing the "commitment chart", prepared and signed by all the participants in the former event held in Palermo, September 2018. This year, the scope is to track the progress of the agreed initiatives and to enrich the chart by listening to the voice of the direct recipients of the initiatives of the writing associations: secondary school students, bachelor and master degree students, PhD students and young professionals. One or more representatives of each category will give their own contribution to the improvement of the commitment chart, turning the spotlight on any faults, weaknesses and strengths of the document. They will be able to express their opinion and share their experience on what has been done so far, defining the path for the future by suggesting new aspects to consider and initiatives to focus on.

The *poster session* GENEVA 2019 (Gender Equality iN rEsearch and innoVAtion) will be an opportunity to share current best-practices in managing the "gender equality" in funded projects. In the frame of IEEE RTSI 2019 - 5th International Forum on Research and Technologies for Society and Industry "Innovation to shape the future" - Firenze, Italy, September 9-12 2019, the IEEE Italy Section Women in Engineering Affinity Group will organize the second edition of *GENEVA (Gender Equality iN rEsearch and innoVAtion)*, aimed to illustrate the best-practices in managing "gender equality" within funded projects.

The poster session will take place on **September 11th, from 10:30 to 11:00**, though the posters will be displayed **for the full duration of the RTSI 2019 conference** in a dedicated "women's corner", and can be put up starting from September 9th. Authors are expected to present their posters discussing their work and answering questions during the poster session. A poster board will be available for each poster and it is the authors' responsibility to bring their own printed poster and put it up before the poster session starts.

Description

The session will be a poster-presentation of projects in which the theme of gender balancing has been dealt with, in line with the Gender Equality plan in R&I - H2020 - "Science with and for Society" work program.

It is expected that the projects shown will go from the more concise treatment to the systematic implementation of the Gender Equality Plan.

Contents

In order to encourage the recognition of similar projects and therefore with the objective that the projects presented can be understood as best practices, an overview of the project (topic, national / European call through which it was financed, resources in terms of budget, instrumentation and months / person required for the development of the project itself) is required.

With reference to the subject of gender balancing, the focus should be on:

- identification of potential critical issues;
- articulation of operational solutions to overcome the critical issues encountered (it is appropriate to highlight in this phase also possible action tools - structures / stakeholders / cultural organizations - reference that have supported the operational aspects);
- ex-post evaluation of the impacts (quantitative, also the possibility to access specific incentives for the promotion of gender and qualitative equity) also through synthetic indicators.

Submission Details

Poster proposal has to be submitted by e-mail to plamberti@unisa.it. Report in the email-subject "GENEVA 2019" and in the email-body the following information:

- a) **poster title**;
- b) **authors list and affiliation** (highlighting the presenter);
- c) **brief overview of the project** (topic, national / European call through which it was financed, resources in terms of budget, months / person required, grade of implementation of the "gender balancing").

An e-mail will be sent confirming the submission success and assigning an ID. A space of A1 dimension (70x100 cm²) will be reserved in the women's corner in order to expose the poster. Digital version of the final poster must be sent by e-mail **before 6th September 2019**. Posters will be included in the conference digital media with the other materials.

All submitted proposals will be included in the poster session.

Submission deadline: proposal ~~August 2nd~~ **August 30th** 2019; digital final format 6th September 2019.
